



Sub-Branch By-Laws

The BY-LAWS of the Sub Branch are set down to maintain a high standard of behavior of members and guests and to ensure the comfort and enjoyment of all members while in the clubrooms.

The Duty Manager is responsible for enforcing the BY-LAWS of the Phillip Island R.S.L. Sub Branch and their decision is final.

Dress Standards

Members, guests and visitors are required to conform to reasonable standards of dress when using the Sub-Branch facilities.

Certain attire is regarded as unsuitable and includes the following:

- No caps or hats to be worn in the club;
- Medical or religious head wear is permitted;
- No singlets or t-shirts without sleeves;
- No offensive advertising or writing on shirts;
- No torn or dirty clothes;
- No tight or brief shorts;
- No soiled footwear;

Minors

Minors are permitted to enter Sub-Branch premises but not to have access to the Gaming Room. Minors are not permitted to consume alcohol. Minors are the responsibility of their Parent /Guardian at all times. Minors under the age of 18 that are not partaking of a meal are required to leave the premises by 8pm nightly. Children are not permitted to purchase items at the bar or any raffle. Children are not permitted to use the pool table or dart boards.

Behaviour

Any member, or guest, using offensive or obscene language or gestures, or who is considered to be intoxicated, violent or quarrelsome, or behaving in an unruly manner will be asked to vacate the Club. A member or guest as described in these rules must not refuse or fail to leave the premises if requested to do so. A member or guest if considered by the committee of the Sub-Branch to be guilty of conduct unbecoming a member may be subject to further disciplinary action in accordance with Sub-Branch rules. This behaviour standard also applies on the courtesy bus.

Guests

Members must sign in their guests and are responsible for their behaviour while in the Club. Guests must vacate the premises with that member, unless signed in by another member.

No Smoking Policy

A no smoking policy exists within all internal areas of the Club.

Consumption of Alcohol

The consumption of alcohol is only permitted within the licensed areas of the Club, these being; the Members Bar, The Gaming Room, The Lone Pine Bistro and the Beer

Garden. Consumption of alcohol is strictly forbidden in the car park and the grass surrounds of the Club unless approved for special functions. No alcohol (or food) is to be consumed while traveling on the Courtesy Bus. Only alcohol that is purchased from the Club can be consumed at the Club. No takeaway liquor is to be consumed on premises.

Members Benefits

Members must produce a financial card when requested, to become eligible for Sub-Branch member benefits. In addition to financial Members being entitled to members benefits, such benefits are also made available to Honorary Temporary Members as well, including New Member applicants and Financial Members of other RSL Sub-Branches and the RSL HQ unattached list. Ask at reception for a description of member benefits.
